

Frequently Asked Questions for Customers

Why is the name changing?

The name KLA-Tencor is 22+ years old, and we wanted to refresh the name, colors and logo to reflect our updated outlook and culture.

What is the official name change? When does the change take place?

The company's legal name is changing to KLA Corporation effective approximately July 15, 2019.

What entities will change their name?

Only the U.S. corporate entity's legal name will be changed at that time.

What do I need to change and when?

Nothing changes prior to July 15, 2019. Thereafter, purchase order placement and related payment may change depending on the location from which the product or parts will be shipping. Please see the table below for details.

What happens if I send a purchase order in the old name after the name change goes into effect?

Purchase orders and payment will be accepted as KLA Corporation or KLA-Tencor Corporation for a short time after the name change takes effect. However, please keep in mind that for export or L/C controlled shipments, documentation inconsistencies dramatically increase the risk that a shipment or related payment may be delayed or rejected.

Will existing customer agreements, including master agreements, need to be updated or renegotiated because of the name change?

No, there will be no need to change existing agreements, because the name change does not trigger an assignment, transfer, or change of control. Existing agreements will continue to be valid and honored.

Will the banking information change?
