

Take-Back and Recycling in the EU—WEEE

KLA takes its obligations to protect the environment seriously and in accordance with the EU Directive 2012/19/EU on Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE), provides this important information to its customers.

Electrical and electronic products can negatively impact the environment and human health if not disposed of properly, and our customers have a role to play in contributing to recycling and reusing old WEEE.

WEEE must be collected separately at the end of their life cycle and disposed of in a specific way. This is indicated by the crossed-out bin symbol, which is printed on applicable KLA products.

WEEE will be taken back by KLA and disposed of free of charge on a one-for-one like-for-like basis.

Through cooperation with "Recycling Network Europe AG" (RENE AG) (a third-party consulting organization which supports KLA in complying with the requirements of the relevant EU environmental directives and its country-specific implementations) KLA provides its customers with a Europe-wide network of take-back programs that collect WEEE and recycle it professionally. If you wish to return your products purchased from KLA, please contact the country's local KLA support team or EHS representative. Contact details can be found on the main website.

Like electrical and electronic products, the substances contained in **batteries and luminaires** (lamps) can negatively impact the environment and human health if not disposed of properly. We therefore ask you to remove batteries and luminaires (lamps) from the products and to dispose of them properly via local authority or civic amenity sites or recycling facilities free of charge.

WEEE and waste batteries should never be placed in standard household/ commercial waste bins.



WEEE Registrations

In accordance with European and country-specific requirements, the individual EU subsidiaries of KLA are registered with the respective authority or take-back program responsible for implementing the WEEE Directive.
